

DOMESTIC GAS DIPLOMA

Introduction:

This training and assessment course has been designed and specifically developed for individuals seeking Gas Safe Registration for the first time.

The Gas Diploma course that we offer has been approved by the Gas Industry Standard Setting Body, Energy and Utility Skills, and is fully certificated by Cert-ain certification Ltd.



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You will be required to attend full tutorial classes over a set period and cover all the theory and practical aspects of the Gas Diploma programme. This can be done **FULL TIME** (Weekdays) or **PART TIME** (Evenings & Weekends)

Alongside the training programme you are required to build up an "ON SITE" evidence portfolio. This can be achieved by working with and being supervised by a current Gas Safe registered engineer / engineers.

Individuals who are successful in achieving the Gas Diploma qualification are then eligible to undertake relevant domestic gas assessments for the Nationally Accredited Certification Scheme for Individual Gas Fitting Operatives (**ACS CCN1 and appliances**)

All successful individuals will be issued with a Cert-ain Certification Ltd. domestic gas diploma / ACS certificate.

Eligibility:

There are no pre-requisites for applicants wishing to undertake the Gas Diploma; however, they should possess reasonable levels of English and Mathematics.

*Applicants will be required to gain and provide evidence of a range of relevant gas work experience under the supervision of a Gas Safe registered installer.

Course Content:

Candidates will cover a wide range of topic areas, including *Health & Safety, Gas Legislation, Pipework, Ventilation, Flues and Chimney's, Controls, Unsafe Situations, Appliances and more.* Please refer to the course qualification Handbook for a more detailed overview.

All tools, materials and handouts are provided, and candidates will also receive the full set of gas textbooks, and ring binder portfolio that accompany this course.

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Training & Assessment Methods:

Candidates will receive full training, and will be assessed throughout the programme, and also at the end. Assessments will be both practical, and theory with short written response and multiple-choice answers required.

Achievements & Progression:

Upon successful completion of the Gas Diploma and the ACS CCN1 assessments, candidates will be able to register themselves, or their business, with the Gas Safe Register.

Progression routes are available to candidates once registered with Gas Safe, and can include the following:

- Additional Gas Appliances (Boilers, Cookers, Fires, Meters, Warm Air)
- LPG Changeover (Domestic, Residential Park Homes, Caravans /Motorhomes /Boats)
- Commercial Gas Changeover (Heating)
- Commercial Gas Changeover (Catering)
- Boiler Fault Finding and Essential Electrics
